#### 1 Peter 4:12-14,

<sup>12</sup>Dear friends, do not be surprised at the fiery ordeal that has come on you to test you, as though something strange were happening to you. <sup>13</sup> But rejoice inasmuch as you participate in the sufferings of Christ, so that you may be overjoyed when his glory is revealed. <sup>14</sup> If you are insulted because of the name of Christ, you are blessed, for the Spirit of glory and of God rests on you. <sup>6</sup> Humble yourselves, therefore, under God's mighty hand, that he may lift you up in due time. <sup>7</sup> Cast all your anxiety on him because he cares for you. <sup>8</sup> Be alert and of sober mind. Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour. <sup>9</sup> Resist him, standing firm in the faith, because you know that the family of believers throughout the world is undergoing the same kind of sufferings. <sup>10</sup> And the God of all grace, who called you to his eternal glory in Christ, after you have suffered a little while, will himself restore you and make you strong, firm and steadfast. <sup>11</sup> To him be the power for ever and ever. Amen.

### **CRAFT ACTIVITY**


#### WALK BOLDLY WITH JESUS SHOE

You will Need:

- · Coloured paper
- Pencils/Textas/Crayons
- Pipe cleaners
- · Heart and cross printed out.



Cut out the cross and heart. Put to the side. Put the coloured paper on the floor and trace around your foot to make a shoe shape. Cut it out. Make 3 small holes for the pipe cleaners, as in the picture above. You will need 2 shorter pipe cleaners. Push them through from the front and fold over at the back to keep them secure. Write the words, "WALK BOLDLY WITH JESUS" in the middle of your show. Stick on the cross and the heart.

### **MUSICAL CHAIRS: Be Bold, Move Quickly**



Put your favourite music on and nominate someone to be the music controller. Place chairs in a circle all facing out. You need 1 less chair than people playing. When the music plays walk around the ring of chairs. When the music stops claim a chair by sitting on it. The person who doesn't have a chair is out. Keep playing until 1 person is left.
