### Matthew 20:25-28

Jesus called them together and said, "You know that the rulers of the Gentiles lord it over them, and their high officials exercise authority over them. Not so with you. Instead, whoever wants to become great among you must be your servant, and whoever wants to be first must be your slave— just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many."



Everyone is called to serve!! We serve when we share God's amazing, grace-filled love with those around us.

## **CRAFT ACTIVITY**

## **SERVANT BOX**

Jesus showed his love for us by dying for each of us. It was the ultimate act of servant love. A cube when it is flat looks just like a cross, so we are going to use that shape to think of ways we can serve.



#### You will need:

- Cube pattern print out (at the end of the guide)
- Scissors
- Glue
- Textas, pencils. crayons

Print off the cube template. You can have 1 each, or one for the family. Think of something you can do to show servant love to your family, your friends, neighbours and others you meet. You might like to create a family list. In each square of the cube pattern draw or write 1 thing you thought of. Fold your cube so the side you wrote on is on the outside and glue the cube together. Rolling the cube is a fun way to remember ways to serve others!

## **ACTIVE ACTIVITY**



### **FIRST ARE LAST**

Jesus showed his disciples a really practical way to serve when he washed their feet. In Jesus time people walked everywhere and there weren't nice clean paths. Their feet were dirty and smelly, and washing them was the job of the servants, not the most important person. Jesus flips everything upside down when he washes his disciples feet.

Think of something you can do for a member of your family. Maybe it is the job they mentioned earlier, or another thing you know they don't like doing, or have to do all the time. You might like to wash their feet, or clothes, or dishes. Be creative and show God's amazing love with another member of your family!!



Think of those you know and love and pray for them. Thank God for putting them in your life and pray for any needs they have.



Name, God has perfectly made you to serve. Amen
