Shhh. WE DON'T TALK ABOUT...



Readings: Ezekiel 34:1-16, 1 Peter 5:1-4

The failure to speak the truth or show compassion when called for. How do we view the failures of the Church? Or when the people of God fail to live up to the standards they proclaim? How do you respond when the Church fails you, disappoints you, lets you down? What happens when people come to Church to find Jesus and sometimes all they find is us. Join us today as we no longer remain silent but open up and talk honestly about 'The Church's failures.'
